

Adytum and Asylum *differ*

Same as Sanctum and Sanctuary

Adytum | Never-setting (of stars); not to be entered (treasure room); innermost sanctuary or shrine. (*Syn.* sanctum) — *Liddell & Scott*

Asylum | Safe from violence; not liable to reprisals. Σύλον was the right of seizing the ship or cargo of a foreign merchant to cover losses received through him. (*Syn.* sanctuary) — *Liddell & Scott*
