Neither liking this nor disliking that.

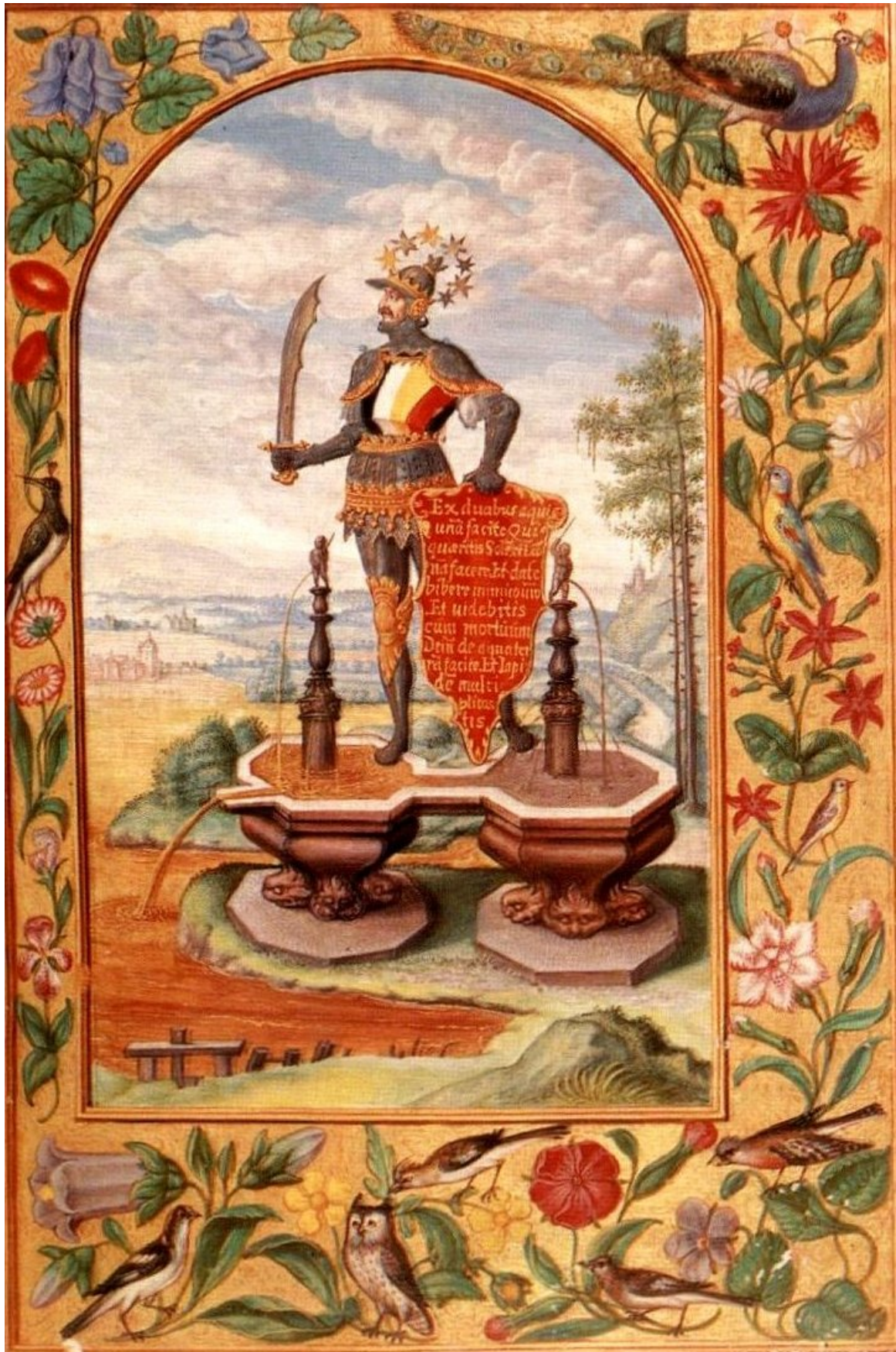
The ego gropes in darkness,
