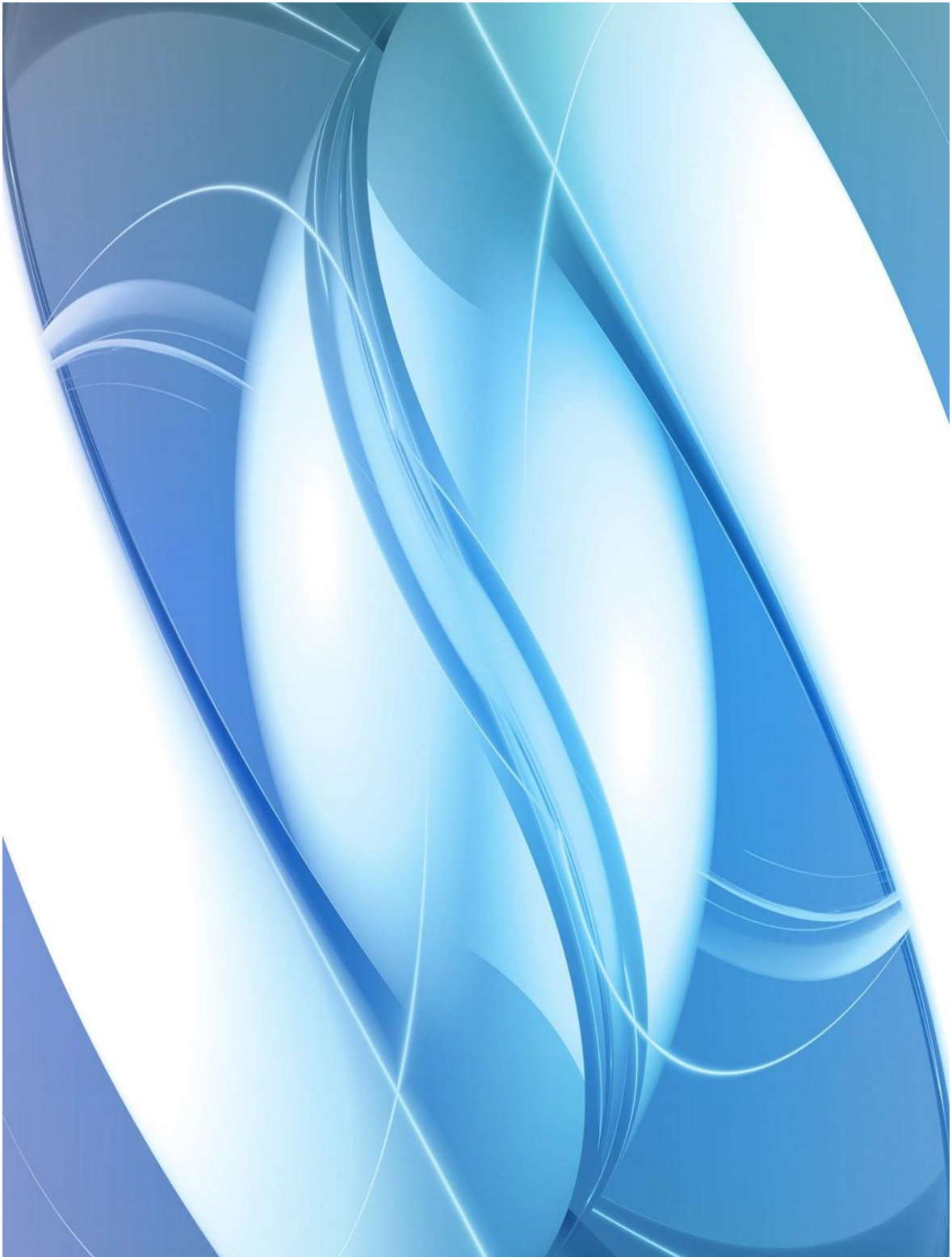


Enoch on those who are in heaven
